- Realizing that you will likely have some degree of debt when you graduate, how do you plan on repaying your debts?

GUIDELINES

The Selection Committee, consisting of Money Smart Week professionals will score each applicant on the following criteria:

- Be a graduating high school senior who is continuing their education at an accredited two or four year post-secondary university or technical/vocational school, within one year of judging notification.
- Have knowledge of money management skills (decision-making related to spending and saving, investing, use of credit, etc.) appropriate for their age and grade level.
- · Live in Northeastern Wisconsin.
- Award recipient only, will be contacted, by email, on or before March 25, 2019.

To Apply:

- Students must write an essay of up to 400 words on the assigned topic.
- Essays must be typed on plain white paper, double-spaced. The Money Smart Scholarship application must be included with the essay; no staples please.
- The essay must be the original work of the student submitting the essay.
- The application form **must be signed** by the student and a parent/guardian.
- The essay and application should be dropped off, mailed, emailed as a PDF, or scanned attachment to:
